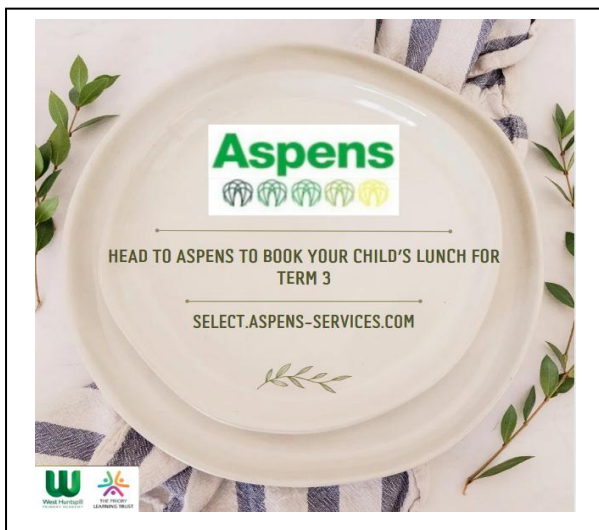

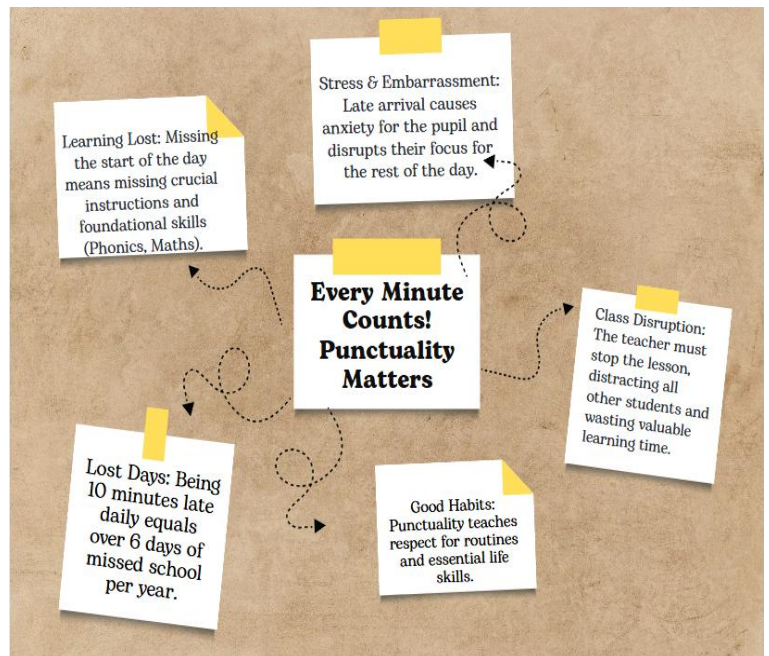
Our School Values
